SAN FRANCISCO (AP) - January 12, 2007 - Need an extra jolt to get you started in the A-M? How about some Meth Coffee?

A San Francisco company is brewing up something new, rich arabica coffee beans combined with tea-like yerba (yur-BAH') mate (mah-TAY').

Yerba mate comes from South America, where it's brewed for beverages. Advocates say it gives an energy boost without the jitters of caffeine. The brains behind Meth Coffee won't reveal their secret recipe, created by a mysterious figure they call "The Roaster."

But the company stresses there's no methamphetamine or anything else illegal in Meth Coffee.
